

If you do not complete the both courses, **you will be restricted from viewing your grades** for the Spring 2024 semester (**July 1 - July 8**), so please complete the Human Rights and Gender Equity and Crime Prevention courses in advance. In particular, the Human Rights and Gender Equity course requires a significant amount of time to complete (approximately **160 minutes of video**), so please complete it in advance.

The changes for the Spring semester of the 2024 academic year are as follows.

1. Course Period: **May 14, 2024 (Tue) ~ August 25 23:59, 2024 (Sun)**

**2. Target:**

**International undergraduate students** belong to Seoul Campus (excluding students belonging to Sejong Campus, students on leave of absence, and graduates)

**3. Courses:**

**2024 Human Rights and Gender Equity Education (for International Students)** : Mandatory course since the Spring semester of the 2017 year to increase sensitivity to human rights and improve gender equality awareness (existing).

**2024 Crime Prevention Education (for international students)**: course provided to international students to increase their understanding of Korean laws and regulations, reduce the possibility of being exposed to crime, and live in a safer environment (**new**).

#### 4. How to Take the Course:

- Log in to Blackboard (<https://kulms.korea.ac.kr>) and take the course.
- When you log in, you will be **automatically** assigned to a class.

#### 2024 Human Rights and Gender Equity Education(for International Students)(Existing)

Log in to Blackboard ► Course ► 2024 Human Rights and Gender Equity Education (for International Students) ► Select language(Korean, Chinese, English) to start training.

- It takes a considerable amount of time to complete the course, so we recommend that you take the course in advance.

#### 2024 Crime Prevention Education (for international students) (New)

Blackboard Login ► Course ► 2024 Crime Prevention Education (for International Students) ► Start training (30 mins video(English only), **no quiz, no certificate print**).

5. Check the completion of the courses in the portal: [Student] Portal-Classes-Education Completion Status Inquiry. You must type in your **portal ID & Password** to complete the course
6. If you do not complete these two courses, **you may be restricted from viewing your grades (July 1<sup>st</sup> ~ July 8<sup>th</sup>)** after the final exam for the Spring 2024 semester.
